

Pictou County RCIP Recommendation Scoring Grids 2026

Scoring and pool system

- Each application will be assessed, then assigned a total score, and applications that meet the minimum requirements will be placed in the application pool.
- To be eligible to enter the pool, each application would have to meet the minimum overall score of 50 points by meeting the minimum score for each eligibility factor (i.e. 10 points each for job offer, language, education, work experience, intent to reside). Note that the maximum score for a single eligibility factor is 25 points.
- The Pictou County Partnership will pull the highest scoring candidates from the pool at the end of each month where a recommendation intake is scheduled, or until the annual allocations have been met. Approximately 7 recommendations will be made each intake period in 2026, or until the annual allocations have been met.
